SEVENTEENTH ANNUAL ART SHOW AND COMPETITION

The Rotary Club of Paraparaumu is holding the Seventeenth Annual Rotary Art Show and Competition in the main auditorium of the Southward Car Museum, Otaihanga Road, Paraparaumu, on the 26th to 28th October this year and we invite you to enter up to three of your works in this event.

Conditions of Entry and an entry form are attached together with details of the prizes offered this year.

We have reduced the entry fees this year to \$30.00 for your first entry, \$50.00 to cover two entries, or \$60.00 total if you enter three.

Prizes are donated by local sponsors and businesses. Entry forms will need to be back with us by **11 October 2019** to give us time to complete display arrangements. Some late entries **may** be accepted, subject to availability of space.

People's Choice prize. Visitors to the Show will vote for their personal choice from all paintings in the exhibition. These votes will be counted after the event closes and the prize will be forwarded to the artist whose work had the highest score.

We are again looking for a high standard of work to be entered, to continue raising the bar for future shows. However, the competition is open to hobby and amateur artists as well as professional artists and this is an opportunity to display your work for sale beside your peers and perhaps to win a prize or an award as well!

You will note from the Conditions of Entry overleaf that this year the Club will increase **commission** from **25% to 30%** on any works sold. The bulk of the net proceeds raised during the weekend will go to the **Kapiti Performing Arts Centre** building fund to help them complete the facility currently under construction. The balance will continue to build the existing Trust Fund created to foster the arts and the artists on the Kapiti Coast.

Please also note the following changes this year:

- **Categories and themes have been dropped this year, to help streamline judging and reduce handling and set up times.**
- **Minimum sale price on any entry has been reduced to \$350.**
- **Receiving of paintings will be on Wednesday 23 October only (between 10am and 4pm). There will be no receiving desk on the Monday or Tuesday as in past years.**
- **Exhibiting artists may purchase Preview Evening tickets for themselves for half the public rate (see Entry Form) and will have free admission to the Show over the weekend (Saturday to Monday inclusive).** Special name tags will be issued to you when your art work is delivered or can be picked up from the entry desk during the weekend.

We look forward to your participation in this event and hope that the success of this year's show will enable us to run an even bigger and brighter show next year.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY, PARAPARAUMU ROTARY ART SHOW 2019

Entries

- Each artist may enter up to three original uncopied 2D paintings, not previously exhibited at this event.
- Entry forms must be received by the **Rotary Art Show Registrar, by post or email**, before 4 p.m. on **Friday 11 October 2019**. Late entries **may** be accepted at the organisers' discretion.
- The entry fees are on a sliding scale, depending on the number entered, and payment of the appropriate amount should be made by a cheque made out to the **Paraparaumu Rotary Art Show**, or by direct credit to the Club's Art Show bank account. **If a painting is not selected for hanging, the entry fee will be refunded.**
- Exhibited paintings will be selected from the entries received. Notification of unselected works will be advised after judging and any such works will be available for collection after the event or by arrangement.
- The Judges of the competition will inspect all paintings and shall be such people as are selected and appointed by the Paraparaumu Rotary Arts Show Committee. The Judges' decisions shall be final and no correspondence will be entered into.
- Artists will allow the Club or its agents to photograph or publish any of the entries in any media for Competition publicity purposes, free of any charges or royalties. No other photography will be permitted during the exhibition.

Presentation

- Each painting must be suitably FRAMED or MOUNTED ready for hanging including cord or wire. Folding D-rings are to be fitted. It is preferred that all stretched canvases are to be backed with stiff card or similar material, to reduce the risk of damage while handling.
- The **largest side** of any entry shall **not exceed 1000 mm including mount and frame**.
- The **minimum price** on any entry shall be **\$350**. Any entry received with a lower price may be rejected.
- Hanging or positioning of the paintings will be at the total discretion of the Club.
- Each painting must have the official catalogue numbers attached (as supplied by the Registrar with your receipt) and the artist's name and the title of the work on the back of the painting **and** on a swing tag.

Delivery

- Entries must be delivered free of all charges to the collection point at the venue. No payment whatsoever will be made by the Club for freight or other charges incurred in delivery or return of any entry
- The Club will exercise all reasonable care in handling the works submitted. The venue is secure, is fitted with security systems and is patrolled. The Club will not be liable for any loss or damage to paintings while in transit to or from the venue.

Packaging and Return Freight

- Unsold paintings must be collected by the artists or their authorised representatives between 4.00 p.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Labour Day, unless other arrangements are made at the time of entry. Production of a copy of the entry form or other form of identification may be necessary. The Club will not be under any liability whatsoever with respect to paintings not collected.
- Any entries not being delivered and/or collected by hand must be presented in suitable reusable packaging. If unable to collect your work, please include prepaid return courier stickers with the entry form or the works or make suitable storage arrangements with the Art Show Director for later pick up. **Charges may be made for upgrading sub-standard return packaging.**

Sales and Commission

- All paintings displayed must be for sale for the duration of the Show at the price endorsed on the Entry Form.
- The paintings selected for display will be on view to the public during exhibition opening hours from 7.30 p.m. on Friday 25 October to 4 p.m. on Monday 28 October 2019. They will not be available for sale before the official opening time on the Friday evening.
- Commission payable to the Club will be at the rate of 30% of the displayed sale price. Net proceeds from these commissions will be used by the Club's Arts Trust of for charitable purposes related to the advancement of Arts on the Kapiti Coast.
- Cheques for net sales proceeds after deduction of commissions will be posted to the successful artists within 4 weeks after the show closes.
